- Ø Transport fees will need to be paid in full at the beginning of each year unless payment arrangement has been made with company director. Paying in full secures a seat to travel to and from school
- Ø The above fees are set fees, if a child is absent from school no refund will be issued

Terms and conditions of travel

- Ø Make sure you and your belongings are inside the bus at all times.
- Ø Not throw anything from a bus window or have anything hanging out a window.
- Ø Get on and off the bus quietly and in an orderly manner.
- Ø Stay in your seat while the bus is moving.
- Ø When you get off the bus only cross the road when the bus has left and it is safe to do so.
- Ø In the morning, arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes prior to departure.
- Ø Not eat or drink while on the bus.
- Ø Should part of the bus be damaged due to child(ren) actions the parent will be notified and liable for all damages.

Responsibilities of parents/guardians

- Ø Parents/guardians are responsible for transporting their children to and from authorised bus stops and their safety at the bus stop while waiting for the bus.
- Ø It is most important that parents waiting for bus passengers at a roadside bus stop should wait on the same side of the road as the bus to prevent accidents.

- Ø Paying fees by the due date
- Ø please note bus fees are not negotiable weather your child comes one day or full term seat is reserved
